Let the 'fun guy,' Greg Carter, of Deep Woods Mushrooms take you deep into the woods and share his excitement for some of the edible products the wild has to offer.

On mushrooms hunts, more properly called "foraging," you will learn:

- Some of the wild edibles which grow in the area.
- Where mushrooms grow in the wild.
- When mushrooms grow during the year.
- How to identify the mushrooms you find.
- The key points of mushrooms hunting.



Classes will be held in and around Pisgah National Forest on Saturday and Sunday afternoons, wherever the mushrooms seem to be making an appearance. Call to find out the meeting place for the hunts.

The cost is \$35 per person; cost includes a wild mushroom manual, a foraging tool, and a collection basket for each participant. Normal group size is six to eight people.

The 'fun guy' is also available for your select group. Please call to schedule a date.

## The Hunt

On the hunt, you will receive the tools of mushroom foraging. You will also gain valuable wisdom and knowledge during a fun activity great for any family or small group.



Make sure all hunters wear proper footwear (closed-

toe shoes with good tread, boots work best) for hiking, long pants, and be prepared for any type of mountain weather (rain coat / rain poncho).
